PSH&TC	Parsons State Hospital and Training Center (one of two State institutions for persons with IDD in Kansas)
QA	Quality Assurance
QRTP	Quality Residential Treatment Facility <i>setting for kids with behavioral issues and developmental disabilities</i>
SACK	Self-Advocacy Coalition of Kansas <i>Can provide training to local self-advocacy groups or Community Councils</i>
SE	Supported Employment
SKAT	Southeast Kansas Area Transit Association

SLP	Shared Living Provider (Host home) <i>An adult with developmental disability can choose to live with a SLP instead of another type of residential setting.</i>
SSDI	Social Security Disability Income
SSI	Supplement Security Income
TCM	Targeted Case Management
TFI	The Farm, Inc. <i>One of four child-placing agencies in the state</i>
TTY	Tele-typewriter (phone for the disabled)
VR	Vocational Rehabilitation <i>State agency who assists with job interest inventories and job placement</i>
YRC	Youth Residential Crisis <i>For kids in crisis who can't stay in their current situation.</i>
YRC2	Youth Residential Crisis <i>for kids with developmental disabilities in crisis</i>
