POLICY

The CDDO shall ensure that persons receiving KDADS funded community services shall receive services consistent with their needs and available funding. At times, it may be necessary for a person's services to be reduced because of changes in their support needs and/or the availability of funding. This determination shall be reached using a person-centered planning process, pursuant to K.A.R. 30-63-21. Reduction of services can occur either voluntarily or involuntarily.

PROCEDURE

The CDDO will work with KDADS and the Managed Care Organization(s), (MCOs), in coordinating and reductions in funding according to existing KDADS/MCO policies.
